What is **Network for Dialogue?**



Launched by the International Dialogue Centre (KAICIID) in 2019, the Network for Dialogue brings together faith-based actors and dialogue practitioners across Europe. By leveraging interreligious and intercultural methods, the Network aims to foster inclusive societies where refugees and migrants are embraced and valued, cultivating communities where everyone feels a profound sense of belonging.



The Network for Dialogue offers members opportunities for capacity-development in dialogue skills and approaches, design and implementation of grassroots dialogue initiatives, and the exchange of practices, including the collection of lessons learned for more effective two-way integration policies, in line with the ideal of “unity in diversity”.





Why join Network for Dialogue?

- 1** **Join a community:** get to know like-minded people who share common ideals and are willing to explore interreligious and intercultural approaches for refugee and migrant integration;
 - 2** **Share reciprocally:** learn from each other; exchange tools, methods, experiences and knowledge; offer and receive support;
 - 3** **Know more:** receive up-to-date research and policy information, participate in trainings and workshops as well as other learning opportunities;
 - 4** **Do more:** cooperate with other Network for Dialogue members to multiply efforts and impact; join opportunities to act at the grassroots level or participate in regional and international projects and events;
 - 5** **Champion:** advocate for interreligious and intercultural dialogue as a key approach to pursue and achieve effective refugee and migrant integration outcomes;
 - 6** **Support policymaking and policy implementation:** promote lessons learned and engage religious leaders and faith actors towards the promotion of effective policies for refugee and migrant integration across Europe.
