COURSE DESCRIPTION

Today, interreligious dialogue (IRD) specialists, Fellows and others need to not only understand their own cultural complexities, but also the need to function effectively in culturally diverse contexts. This includes their personal and private lives, as well as in their workplaces, and within a range of societies, contexts and geographical regions. Furthermore, face-to-face interactions including all the various forms of digital communications, often require a profound intercultural awareness and excellent communication skills. Through this self-paced course, participants will explore theories and practical examples related to intercultural communication. The course is divided into the following four chapters:

- Introduction to Culture, Cultural Identity and Intercultural Communication
- The Cultural Dimensions and Intercultural Communication
- Cultural Analyses and Intercultural Competency
- The Role of Intercultural Communication in Interreligious Dialogue and Peacebuilding.
